



SUICIDE: ENGLAND & WALES STATISTICS 2018-2020





IMPACT OF SUPPORT – ENGLAND AND WALES 2023

- 4272 clients supported
- 75% clients represented to avoid being LiPs
- 4361 children
- 1585 domestic abuse victims
- New cases doubling each year
- Av. res. time 40 (no DA) vs. 14 wks (DA)
- Mental wellbeing scores +3.86 / +7 (DAVE)
- 10/10 Reviews for mentoring
- 100% of Family Court Support service users had a positive outcome
- 5* reviews for Co-parenting workshop
- Full engagement from all Statutory Services





HIGH RISK TRIGGERS FOR MEN FEELING SUICIDAL


- Loss of Contact With Children
- Relationship Breakdown
- Domestic Abuse [Unconscious bias / male victims]
- Unemployment
- Debt
- Bereavement

BARRIERS THAT OUR CLIENTS TELL US THEY FACE

- Accessing support services

- Impact of stigma
- Worries about being deemed to be 'dangerous'
- Monetary
- Parental Conflict / Co-Parenting






A GAP IN THE NATIONAL SUICIDE PREVENTION STRATEGY

- The national suicide prevention strategy lists 'Men' as one of the biggest 'at risk' groups.
- Risk factors identified are:
 - Alcohol and drug misuse
 - Have been in contact with the justice system
 - Experienced financial difficulty
 - Social isolation & isolation
 - Family or relationship problems
- The risk factors being addressed:
 - Financial difficulty
 - Drug and alcohol misuse
